Vini al Bicchiere Wine by the Glass

Frizzanti (Sparkling) 110ml

NV Astoria Lounge Prosecco DOC, Treviso, Veneto, IT \$11

Floral aromas with a nice golden apple on the palate, and hints of pear. Very fine and persistent bubbles with straw yellow and greenish reflections. Creamy palate.

NV Taylors Estate Brut Cuvee, Clare Valley, SA \$12

Crafted from Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, the wine is clean, vivacious citrus flavour with an underlying creamy character and a delicate mousse.

Vini Bianchi (White Wines) 150ml

2016 Knapstein Riesling, Clare Valley, SA \$11

Aroma of fresh lemon drops mingle with granny smith apple and floral notes. Generous citrus flavours with chalky texture and minerality, followed by grapefruit characters, uplifted by a touch of mango on the palate

2016 Block 88 Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, NZ \$10

Bright fruit aromas of passionfruit and nectarine, combined with lifted citrus aromas of mandarin and lime. The palate is full, rich and generous.

2015 Villa Chiopris Pinot Grigio DOC, Friuli, IT \$11

Complex and fresh fine dry. Floral highlights of Jasmine and Acacia, fruit of pear and hint of citrus, persistent and quite balanced.

2015 Pala "I Fiori" Vermentino DOC, Sardegna, IT \$10

Intense floral perfumes with notes of thyme and balsamic. Mineral and vegetable notes are predominant. Smooth with good depth and balance, with a long persistent aftertaste.

2016 Tyrrell's Part & Parcel, Hunter Valley, NSW \$9

Semillion, Verdehlo, Gewurztraminer, Chardonnay
Bright, young, fresh and fragrant with lifted aromatic expression, created to show complexity and structure lining into a gentle soft citrus finish.

2015 Tyrrell's Chardonnay, Hunter Valley, NSW 11

The nose shows lifted citrus with a slight hint of oak, the palate is weighted and generous and has the texture and complexities associated with time on lees.

2015 Yarran Moscato, Yenda, NSW \$8

Lifted floral and rose petal aromas. Sweet luscious palate with a citrusy and slightly sparkling finish.

Rosato (Rose') 150 ml

2016 St. Hallett Rosè, Barossa, SA \$10

Fragrant bouquet filled with raspberry and cherry aromas. Red berry and fresh cherry flavours follow on from the nose, with a subtle spicy under tone. A refreshing dry rosé.

Vini Rossi (Red Wines) 150ml

2016 "42° South Pinot Noir, Tasmania \$12

Spicy, cherry/blackcurrant scented, mixed with red berries fruit aromas. Bright, fresh, rich texture, voluptuous and balanced tannin structure.

2015 Bertani Villa Novare, Valpolicella Classico, DOC Veneto, IT \$13

Corvina 80%, Rondnella 20%. Violet colour red, intense notes of fresh fruits, cherry in particular, black currant, plum, raspberry and spice. In the mouth opens, fresh with a good balance between acidity, sweetness and sapidity.

2015 Paterna Chianti DOCG, Toscana, Italy, Organic \$12

Intense and vinous, fruity with sensation of violet and cherries. The palate is harmonious dry, chalky and slightly tannic.

2014 Collefriso Montepulciano Doc, Abruzzo, IT Organic \$11

Ruby red colour with violet reflections. A strong fruity scent, containing hints of slightly spiced cherry plum. A well balanced and lasting taste.

2013 Printhe Cabernet Sauvignon, Orange, NSW \$10

The fruit profile is distinctively cabernet with blackcurrant, red berries, chocolate, mint and a hint of leaf. Toast and vanilla from the oak, tannins are harmonious and balanced.

2015 Varvaglione Negroamaro del Salento, Puglia, IT \$12

Velvety and soft, rustic and hearty, medium bodied, dark berry-fruit flavours with soft tannins.

2015 Tyrrell's Shiraz Hunter Valley , NSW \$10

Offers red fruits, dustiness but not too much, and light, washy acidity keeps things fresh. Better than you think.

2015 Rusden 'Rippers Creek', Shiraz/Cab Sav, Barossa, SA \$13

82% Shiraz, 18% Cabernet. An awesome Shiraz. Pure fruit driven, fleshy and juicy with herbal notes from the Cabernet. Great weight and concentration, subtle silky tannins and a lovely well balanced tight finish.

NV Astoria Lounge Prosecco DOC Veneto,IT 52

NV Taylors Estate, Brut Cuvee Clare Valley,SA 56

♥ **NV Bellavista Alma Brut, Franciacorta, Lombardia,IT 98**

*Bright yellow in colour and luminous with obvious glints of green. Full and inviting, it embraces hints of sweet ripe fruit, meringue, pastries and candied citrus peel, characterised by strong minerality.

The flavour fully matches the nose, with a creamy, almost crunchy sensation and a texture that combines elegance and lightness, depth and harmony.

♥ **2013 Guise Rosè Brut, by Guy Pitkin** Huntet Valley,NSW 66

*Strawberry characters and a more complex palate with peach and some citrus notes subtly appearing alongside the berry and toasted brioche characters. The sparkle has a creamy, clean and refreshing finish and has good palate length.

NVS Josef Chromy Tasmania 65

Expressive citrus and green apple notes with toasted biscuit aromas complementing the fine creamy texture.

NV Veuve Clicquot Brut, Champagne France 110

Vini Bianchi (White Wine)

Riesling

Aromatic wine displaying flowery, almost perfumed aromas, usually high acidity.

2016 Knappstein Riesling Clare Valley,SA 48

♥ **2015 Frogmore Creek 'F.G.R'** (Forty Grams Residual) Tasmania 56

*Made in an homage to the Germanic Kabinett style, it is loaded with forward fruit, and plenty of luscious residual sugar, but enough fine acid carries the palate to a crisp dry finish.

2009 Pewsey Vale 'The Contours' Eden Valley,SA 68

♥ **2016 Clonakilla Riesling*** Canberra,ACT 66

*Mineral charged, tangy, succulent. Aromas are floral, citrusy, lime and kaffir lime leaf, ginger scented, faintly yeasty. Fresh and flirty, with a good refreshment factor. Effortless drinking.

Pinot Grigio

Refreshing, light. Typically low acidity wines with complexity, rounded, glossy texture, displaying pear, nectarine and spiced apple characters.

Sauvignon Blanc

Structurally light in body and crisp, medium to high acidity, highly aromatic, intensely flavoured from herbal, grassy, to passionfruit and tropical fruit character.

2016 Villa Maria 'Reserve' Marlborough,NZ 67

♥ **2013 Guise "Fume Blanc"*** Orange,NSW 48

*Slow ripening, high altitude and cool climate grapes have been partially fermented and aged producing a 'fume blanc' style. Gooseberry, spice and white peach on the nose are complemented to a long and gratifying palate.

Semillon & Blend

Usually picked early with great longevity, semillon can be intriguing, rich, medium bodied, complex and mineral with citrus, grassy aromas, honey and toast flavours when aged.

♥ **2016 Tyrrell's 'Part & Parcel' Hunter Valley,NSW 38**

*(Semillion, Verdehlo, Gewurztraminer, Chardonnay)

This is a take on a classic European Style. The concept being to leverage everything that Tyrrell's has to offer. A sophisticated but comfortable wine to enjoy.

2012 Cullen 'Mangan' Semillon Biodynamic Margaret River,WA 68

Verdelho

Light bodied, fresh, clean, modern, fruit driven, showing citrus to tropical fruit flavours and aromas.

2014 Sandalford Estate Margaret River,WA 56

2015 Tyrrell's Special Release Hunter Valley,NSW 49

Garganega

Widely grown in Veneto particularly around Verona. It is the primary grape of the Soave wine region, also with Trebbiano and Chardonnay.

The grape can produce delicate wine with lemon, almond and spicy notes

♥ **2014 Filippi 'Castelcenerino' Soave Classico Veneto,IT 64**

*100% Garganega. Organic/Biodynamic/Natural culture from 70 year old vines.

Very elegant, structured and generous, with fresh white floral aromas, driven by pear, apple blossom, ginger and almond with great minerality on the palate and a persistent finish.

Passerina

Grown mostly in the Marche region, this variety has been given the name 'Passerina' referring to the bird swallow-tail, that has a particular liking for the grape. Fruity on the nose with floral jasmine. Dry with medium acidity.

♥ **2015 Le Caniette 'Lucrezia', IGP, Organic Marche,IT 56**

*100% Passerina. Straw yellow with green hues in colour.

Aromatics of acacia flowers, yellow peach, pear, citrus fruit with a slightly mineral edge. The wine is fresh, savoury, soft well-balanced on the palate.

Vermentino

Aromatic white from the Mediterranean island of Sardegna. The most famous Vermentino is the DOCG from Gallura in the north of the island. This variety produces wine with firm acidity, bodied and minerals, all a reflection of the sandy and granitic terrain and exposure to the sea breeze in which they are cultivated.

2015 Pepper Tree Limited Release Hunter Valley,NSW 48

♥2015 Funtanaliras 'Oro' Vermentino di Gallura DOCG Sardegna,IT 72

*100% Vermentino. Brilliant straw yellow, with green hues. Crisp and fruity with a great structure and aromatic roundness. Elegant bouquet of quince, acacia flower, elderflower and ripe fruits on the nose, apricot and almonds on the palate, great acidity and good length. A great bottle of wine.

Carricante

Carricante is an ancient grape variety from Sicily, growing on the volcanic slopes of the mountain Etna which the sandy, rich in mineral terrain produce a marked acidity wine. It offers a wide range of refreshing citrus aromas from lemon to grapefruit alongside with herbal notes such as mint and aniseed.

2013 Cantine Russo,Luce di Lava,Etna Bianco, DOP Sicily,IT 68

70% Carricante, 30% Cataratto. Straw yellow color with greenish hues, this is a full-bodied, balanced wine with hints of tropical fruit and citrus. Taste is persistent, fresh, with distinct mineral notes.

Chardonnay

The most widely planted white grape in the world. Able to produce full bodied, structural, textured wine with classic butter, vanilla, crème brulee flavours, coming from ageing in the barrel, to lemon, apple blossom, melon, fig.

2013 Stefano Lubiana 'Primavera', Biodynamic Tasmania 68

2013 Villa Maria 'Reserve Barrique Fermented' Gisborne,NZ 86

♥2013 Canobola Smith Estate Blue Label Orange,NSW 82

*This wine shows an abundance of stonefruit characters and freshness. Oak and aging allows the wine to develop secondary characters of honey, toast and nuttiness.

Honestly one of the best Chardonnays I have ever tasted.

♥2014 Isole e Olena 'Collezione de Marchi' Toscana,IT 92

*Fresh and aromatic with cream, ripe pineapple and lime aromas that follow through to a full body, with lively honey, ripe apple and toasty oak character. Long and rich with intense flavour.

Vini Rosati (Rose' Wine)

2016 St. Hallett Rosè

Barrossa, SA 39

♥ **2016 Kalleske Rosina, Grenache, Shiraz, Viogier, Organic**

Barossa, SA 54

*Rosina is vivid rose-pink in colour with aromatics of raspberry, sweet-sour cherry, nectarine, musk and jasmine. The palate is bright, fresh and juicy with flavours of crushed red berries and watermelon. Vibrant and crisp, completed by a generous lingering finish.

Vini Rossi (Red Wine)

Pinot Noir

One of the most difficult wines to produce. Its aroma is more complex than all of the other varietals with black cherry, roses, pronounced spices, ripe tomato, mushroom, dead leaves. It could be full bodied and rich but not heavy or high in alcohol, yet neither acidic or tannic, with substantial flavour despite its delicacy. The most appealing quality of pinot noir may be its soft, velvety texture.

♥ **2015 Giant Step Pinot Noir**

Yarra valley, VIC 68

*The relatively light colour and perfumed bouquet are typical of this vineyard, as is the understated elegance and finesse of the palate, spicy/savoury red fruits and silky tannins in a back-up role.

2014 Pipers Brook Estate Pinot Noir

Tasmania 84

♥ **2015 St Michael Eppan 'Blauburgunder'**

Alto Adige, IT 86

*This pinot noir develops to its full potential with its garnet red colour. Aromas of wild berries, raspberry and blackberry, yielding to a structured wine with an elegant full fruity-spiced palate. St. Michael Eppan is the elite, the aristocracy. In short the very top flight of Italian wine.

Lagrein

This Northern Italian variety offers wine of an intense dark colour, fruit driven and spiced, yet on the palate it is lighter than expected. Rustic.

♥ **2014 Tiefenbrunner 'Turmhof'**

Alto Adige, IT 68

*100% Lagrein. Deep garnet red in colour, with a delicate bouquet showing the cherry and violet notes characteristic of the varietals; subtle wood tones complement its full and round fruit flavours. Compact tannins and an agreeable acidity carry this traditional South Tyrolean wine through to its long finish.

Corvina/Rondinella

Corvina and Rondinella are two grape varieties commonly blended together in the making of famous Valpolicella wine and its prestigious Amarone. Corvina plays the main role usually, with Rondinella as backup, creating a typically light-coloured, medium-bodied wine with noticeable astringency on the palate.

♥2015 Bertani Villa Novare, Valpolicella Classico, DOC Veneto, IT 58

*Corvina 80%, Rondinella 20%. Manual harvest. Violet colour red, intense notes of fresh fruits, cherry in particular, black currant, plum, raspberry and spice. In the mouth opens, fresh with a good balance between acidity, sweetness and sapidity.

♥2011 Freeman Secco Rondinella Corvina Hilltop, NSW 76

*A local, Australian take on the Valpolicella and Amarone wines of Italy. Very complex and savoury, with toast, vanilla and dark cherry aromas.

To create the Freeman 'Secco' Rondinella Corvina a portion of the grapes are dried in a prune dehydrator. The grapes are layered on racks and gently heated in air tunnels, a process that concentrates flavours and modifies the tannin structure of the seeds. The dried grapes are then added to the fermentation tanks. Subsequently aged for 12 months in a combination of old French and American oak barriques.

Fiasco Riserva:

2011 Viviani Amarone della Valpolicella Classico Veneto, IT 168

Viviani wines are made with the utmost thought for tradition. All grapes are picked by hand and carried to the drying room where the "appassimento" process can begin.

Dark ruby red colour, consistent, on the nose intense and complex with notes of blackberry, cherries, flowers as violet and dried red roses, sweet spicy scents of vanilla, coffee and leather. The warm and smooth sensations related to the freshness and elegant tannins make this robust and opulent wine an excellence among the most typical Amarones.

2005/06 Bertani Amarone della Valpolicella Veneto, IT 216

Unlike most local producers Bertani owns its own vineyards allowing control over the entire production process. Bertani use natural drying methods putting the grapes to rest in the drying room refusing to use any kind of artificial conditioning. This is not due to any "philosophical" choice, but the tried and tested conviction that this is the only way to get great and distinctive Amarone wine, where elegance prevails over power.

A perfumed nose with crushed red roses, black cherry and spicy tobacco. Immense depth and complexity on the palate: dried fruit, oolong tea, liquorice, spice, red-berry fruits, and a long velvety vanilla note on the finish.

Sangiovese

Light-medium bodied dry red with aromas floating from the delicate floral cherry aromas of Chianti to the intensely dark and tannic wines of Brunello di Montalcino. Sangiovese wine has something for everyone.

2015 Paterna Chianti Colli Aretini, DOCG Organic Toscana,IT 56

2013 Chapel Hill 'Il Vescovo' McLaren Vale,SA 50

♥2013 Isole e Olena, Chianti Classico DOCG Toscana,IT 85

*One of the most iconic Chianti, it's a beauty, must try! Beautiful sour cherry and red fruit character, the palate is full of perfumed fruit and structure coming from the taut acidity and tannin.

2014 Argiano, Rosso di Montalcino, DOC Toscana,IT 68

100% Sangiovese Grosso. It is medium bodied, elegant in the mouth. It is well balanced with tempting flavours of red berries, violets, menthol and earthiness. A generous wine with smooth, velvety tannins.

Fiasco Riserva:

2004 Hamiltons Bluff, Sangiovese Canowindra, NSW 126

Hamiltons Bluff's Sangiovese wines are a fine example of how well the variety can perform in a warmer climate Australian wine region. It's a 15.4 per cent alcohol sangiovese. It tastes sweet and ripe with burnt sugar, toast, raspberries, liquorice flavours, spicy bouquet with fairly savoury characters on the palate; fine tannins, good length.

2009 Silvio Nardi, Brunello di Montalcino Toscana, IT 196

Tenute Silvio Nardi consists of 80 hectares of vineyards in an unspoilt part of central Tuscany: Montalcino, whose symbol is its great red wine, Brunello. Intense ruby red colour with garnet highlights. Clean, sophisticated, intense and complex aromas, rich in evolved overtones, with hints of anise, ripe wild berries and a light touch of vanilla. Warm with supple tannins, great structure, good length and considerable ageing capacity.

Barbera

Barbera is the quintessential 'table wine' and the second most important variety after Nebbiolo, in the native region of Piedmont, Italy. It tastes both rich and light bodied with notes of blackberries and cherry, with light tannin and high acidity.

♥2014 Bricco Maiolica Barbera d'Alba, DOC Piemonte,IT 68

*This Barbera is very pleasant and easy to drink. Bouquet of red currant and nectarine. Very fruity wine with sensation of blueberry, black cherry, plum and mulberry. Very velvety with little acidity.

2014 Zarella "La Gita" Barbera McLaren Vale,SA 62

Dolcetto

Dolcetto, which literally means "just a little bit sweet", is often associated as the cousin of Barbera. The grape produces dry, soft styled fruity wines, characterized by low acidity and bitey tannins.

♥ **2013 Bricco Maiolica Dolcetto Diano d'Alba, DOCG**

Piemonte, IT 68

*A classic deep red colour with violet shade Dolcetto with a delicate bouquet of ripe cherry, fruity flavour with a pleasant almond aftertaste.

Merlot, Montepulciano & Blend

Considered 'easy-drinking' varieties thanks to their moderate tannins, which are soft and approachable. Both varieties exhibit dark fruit flavours such as cherry and plum, although Merlot is more easily identified by its silken texture.

2014 Collefriso Montepulciano Doc, Organic*

Abruzzo, IT 54

*100% Montepulciano d'Abruzzo DOC. Ruby red colour. A strong fruity scent, containing hints of spices, cherry plum and jam. A well balance and lasting taste.

2014 Heskett 'Montepulciano'*

Barossa, SA 52

*Keeping with a traditional Italian Montepulciano, this wine is deeply coloured with a smooth lingering and complex finish.

2013 Philip Shaw 'No 17', Merlot, Cab. Franc, Cab Sauv Orange, NSW 56

Negroamaro

Puglia's Salento Peninsula is arguably the source of the finest Negroamaro wines. The wine tends to be rustic and hearty, medium bodied, dark berry-fruit flavours with soft tannins.

2015 Varvaglione '12 e mezzo' Negroamaro del Salento*

Puglia, IT 56

*Ruby red- colour with reddish purple hues. Its charming smell reminds of mixed berries. Its taste is enhanced by long-lasting vanilla nuances. Its flavour is velvety and soft.

Nero d'Avola

The most important and widely planted red wine grape variety of Sicily. Nero d'Avola means "Black of Avola", a reference to the grape's distinctive dark colour. Medium bodied, the nose can be pretty, floral and spicy, yet earthy and meaty with lots of red fruits.

♥ **2015 Fondo Antico, Nero d'Avola,**

Sicilia, IT 58

*The wine offers a clean portrait of the Sicilian indigenous grape, with tones of red cherry, blackberry, red rose and lightly toasted almond. The tannins are soft and silky.

♥ **2013 Mount Horrocks, Nero d'Avola, Organic Clare Valley, VIC 76**

*This late-ripening variety seems ideally suited to the Australian climate. Exuberant dark stone fruits stewed plum and prune, with hints of tobacco leaf and lifted spice. It is joyous and vibrant.

Primitivo/Zinfandel

The name Primitivo translates roughly as 'early' one and refers to the variety's early-ripening nature. Rich, concentrated and hearty, developed well under the hot Italian sun, Primitivos tend to be juicy and well structured, aromas and flavours of ripe blackberries, violets and pepper are common.

2014 Varvaglione '12 e mezzo' Primitivo del Salento* Puglia,IT 56

*This wine has an elegant ruby-red colour and its intense smell has fruity nuances of ripe plums and cherry jam. Slightly spicy with a hint of cocoa with a finish of vanilla. Good in texture, great structure, this wine is soft and full of ripe tannins.

2009 Rusden 'Chookshed', Zinfandel Barossa,SA 96

Cannonau/Grenache

Cannonau, the local name for the Grenache, is a red wine from the Italian island of Sardegna. It has long been thought that the variety arrived on Sardegna with the Aragonese when they conquered the island in the early 14th Century but it's believed now that this grape actually originates from Sardegna.

2014 Rusden 'Driftsend',Grenache,Shiraz,Mataro Barossa,SA 50 ♥2013 Giuseppe Sedilesu ' Mamuthone' Sardegna,IT 78

*100% Cannonau. A full expression of Cannonau's character: clear notes of spice, ripe black cherry, liquorice. A dense and fresh palate with firm, balanced tannins, and a simple unique depth.

♥2014 Kalleske 'Old Vine' Grenache, Organic Barossa,SA 89

*Lifted nose displays strong varietal aromatics of rose perfume, clove spice, musk and raspberry, as well as mint, chocolate and a touch of herbs. The palate is full-flavoured. Ripe and juicy with raspberry, cherry and a hint of liquorice. There are super-fine natural tannins adding structure.

Carignano del Sulcis

The Carignano grape, which is believed to have been introduced to the island by the Phoenicians around the 9th century B.C., seems to have found a perfect spot in the hot, dry south west corner of Sardegna, in the Sulcis area. Full-bodied wine with a well structured flavour, rich and intense bouquet, carrying scents of stewed prunes, dried fruit and black cherries.

♥2010 Sardus Pater 'Is Arenas'Riserva Sardegna,IT 78

*100% Carignano. Intense and compact ruby red. It affects the sense of smell a high sweet spiciness, followed by notes of jammy berries, sage and rosemary.

He wraps himself sumptuous and velvety in the mouth with soft and elegant tannins, accompanied by a lively freshness and a passionate note salt. It is warm and Mediterranean, recalls with accuracy the land from which it comes.

Nebbiolo

Nebbiolo is the grape variety behind the world regarded red wines of Piedmont which are Barolo and Barbaresco. Nebbiolo wines are distinguished by their strong tannins, high acidity and distinctive scent of tar, roses, prunes and chocolate.

♥2012 Mamete Prvostini, 'Sassella', Valtellina Superiore

Lombardia, DOCG IT 88

*100% Nebbiolo. Purple colour, aromas of blueberry and blackberry flavour, robust yet silky, with liquorice final and almond aftertaste.

Fiasco Riserva:

2010 Mamete Prvostini, 'Sassella Riserva', Valtellina Superiore

Lombardia, DOCG IT 154

100% Nebbiolo. Late Harvest. First fermentation in stainless steel with 18 days of maceration on the skins followed by 24 months in oak and another 12 months in bottle to finish.

Ruby Red-deep garnet with hints of orange. Important fruits, jam aroma with spices, enveloping, warm and intense flavour.

2009/10 Marchesi di Barolo, Barolo DOCG Piemonte, IT 186

The Abbona Family continues the work that began more than two centuries ago.

100% Nebbiolo. The colour is garnet red with ruby hues. The aroma is intense and persistent with clean scents of spices, cinnamon, absinthe, tobacco and rose bush. The taste is full and elegant and with soft tannins. The spice and the boisè blend perfectly.

GAJA

Gaja is one of the stars of the world wine scene, a producer that is widely credited with transforming not just the image and international reputation of its native Piedmont region, but of Italy as a whole. It has had a significant impact on the way that Italian wine is grown, made, priced, distributed and marketed. Gaja is one of a handful of fine wine brands that can compete with and charge the same prices as the top names of Burgundy and Bordeaux.

♥2013 Gaja Barbaresco DOP

Piemonte, IT 298

100% Nebbiolo. The 2013 Barbaresco shows precise and clean perfumes. Initial citrusy notes lead to a sweet fruit expression of wild strawberry, tropical notes of guava and passion fruit. The finish is distinctly floral with nuances of rose, elderflower, violet, musk and white pepper. The palate shows juicy and smooth tannins along with a pure and lean body. Its character is elegant and harmonious, not exuberant nor austere.

♥2011 Gaja Sperss Langhe Nebbiolo, DOC Piemonte, IT 374

94%Nebbiolo 6%Barbera. Ruby red color. Aromas are dark, pure and very fruit focused with classic hints of tar, licorice, and a touch of truffles. On the palate, Sperss displays the austere character typical of the terroir: deep structure and lots of ripe tannins. Dense, massive yet seamless, the beautifully integrated wine possesses low acidity as well as a terrific finish.

Aglianico

Probably what the emperors of ancient Rome used to drink. Mostly grown in the southern part of Italy it is known to produce full-bodied red wine, with impressive structure, high acidity, firm tannins yet do not lack fruit and good ageing potential.

2014 Terre di Briganti Aglianico del Sannio DOC* Organic Campania, IT 62

*100% Aglianico. This wine best summarizes typology, territory, structure and longevity of the Aglianico wine and the volcanic soil from which it comes. Bright ruby red, intense and ethereal bouquet, dry to the palate, velvety with ageing.

Cabernet Sauvignon

Widely recognized as the 'king of wines', the classic profile of Cabernet Sauvignon tends to be full-bodied. Dark fruit flavours with high tannins and noticeable acidity that contributes to the wine's ageing potential.

2013 Printhe 'Mountain range' Orange, NSW 48

♥2006 Canobola Smith Orange, NSW 68

*Canobolas-Smith Wines, is small family company making premium quality wines. All the vines are close-planted, hand pruned and hand picked to optimise fruit quality and an artisanal approach to winemaking.

The 2006 Cabernet Sauvignon shows plenty of fruit: ripe blackberry beautiful plum and milk chocolate paired with leafy/tobacco notes and earthiness with fine tannins.

♥2015 Kalleske 'Merchant', Organic Barossa, SA 59

*Aromatics of blackcurrant, cedar, aniseed, dark chocolate and cherry. The palate is medium bodied with varietal juicy fruit. Tannins are prominent but very fine adding definition, structure and age-worthiness. Integrated oak adds complexity and a lengthy finish.

2015 Bowen Estate Coonawarra, SA 72

The nose is full of rich dark berry characteristics with nuances of classic Coonawarra mint. The wine has a very well structured palate well supported by fine tannins. Showing great flavour and softness with lingering finesse leaving you asking for more.

2012 Rusden 'Boundaries' Barossa, SA 115

Fiasco Riserva:

2003 Turners Crossing Cabernet Sauvignon Bendigo, VIC 94

This vintage was an extraordinary year for grapes in Victoria. This aged beauty still has plenty of fruit on the nose, where mulberry and blackcurrant mingle with plums and a hint of black olive and cigar box. The palate is enhanced with earthy nuances and plum-like flavours, finishing up firm with ripe tannins.

2013 Lake's Folly* Cabernet Sauvignon Hunter Valley, NSW 148

*Lifted perfumed nose of red cherries and cassis, with scents of violets and cedar. It is clean, pure and vibrant. The palate is silky and smooth, with fine seamless tannins, a great mid-palate sweetness and a long finish. A medium bodied style.

Shiraz/Syrah + Blend

Australian Shiraz are usually full bodied, producing rich, ripe, intense fruit flavoured wine. Syrah are slightly leaner, with more complex spice, earthiness and softer tannins. If you like bold, fruit forward wines with tannin, stick with Shiraz. If you're looking for something a little more elegant and complex, the Syrah could be a good option.

Plums and blackberries with hints of leather, roast meat, herb, pepper and exotic spice characters dominate the nose with a touch of the hallmark violet and mocha. A full bodied, rich, powerful and velvety smooth palate with a very long finish, it has a long life ahead of it.

A perfumed nose, overflowing with spice and violets, miles of velvety, soft fruit and mellow oak, and a great, integrated spine to ensure it ages as well as any Black Guts ever made. This Black Guts is big, but it dances ever so gracefully.

♥ **2015 Clonakilla Shiraz Viognier** **Canberra,ACT** **174**

*This the most highly anticipated release Clonakilla have ever had, and the best vintage yet to date. It is a rare beauty, to see a shiraz-based wine that delivers power in such an elegant way. Incredibly detailed and floral-scented. Silky texture, a symphony of character in fragrance, game meats, herbs, red berries, clove and sweet spice. The palate is incredible: supple, pliant, long, satiny yet etched with the finest tawny work of lacy tannin. It is a thinker's wine.
